

### **EDUCATING** BLACK AMERICA

Before the American Civil War, educating slaves was illegal. Free blacks could go to school if they could find a school. Few "nonblack" colleges would admit black students, and there were only three black colleges in the United States. The first of these schools was the African Institute in Cheyney, Pennsylvania, which became the Institute for Colored Youth (now called Cheyney University). The school began in 1837 with \$10,000 from Richard Humphreys, a white Quaker silversmith. He specified in his will to establish a school for those of African descent. Members of the Quaker religion often worked against slavery, and this became the

## **Being Female** in America

Despite being granted the right to vote almost 100 years ago, women in America have not achieved equality with men. Yet the way that women are viewed and treated is so entrenched in cultural norms that the differences between the female and male experience are not obvious to many.
